

California Transparency in Supply Chains Act U.K. Modern Slavery Act Disclosure Statement

This statement is made on behalf of Park-Ohio Holdings Corp. and its worldwide subsidiaries and affiliates (collectively "ParkOhio"). ParkOhio supports human rights and social responsibility. ParkOhio's directors, officers, employees, and suppliers are required to comply with our <u>Code of Business Conduct and Ethics</u> and report violations thereof to <u>appropriate resources</u>, including our legal and <u>compliance department</u>. Noncompliance with our legal and ethical standards may result in disciplinary action, up to and including termination.

ParkOhio does not currently have formal policies or procedures in place that specifically require (i) verification of product supply chains regarding human trafficking and slavery; (ii) supplier audits regarding human trafficking and slavery; (iii) certifications from suppliers as to whether materials incorporated into their products comply with applicable laws regarding slavery and human trafficking; or (v) training on supply chain risks regarding human trafficking and slavery.

This statement was approved by the Park-Ohio Holdings Corp. Board of Directors and covers ParkOhio's activities for the financial year ending December 31, 2023.
